ABOUT SEU

Georgian National University SEU is one of the most distinguished universities in the higher education space of our country with a history of 20 years.

SEU has been focusing on development since its establishment. The University aims to create a university environment in line with international standards, where the synthesis and internationalization of strong theoretical, practical and research components in the learning process will ensure the training of competitive professionals for national and international markets.

In a short period of time, the University has been able to gain trust and popularity in the Georgian educational space - with educational programs meeting modern standards and requirements, with the efforts of highly qualified academic staff, effective teaching methods, introduction of new technologies and innovative approaches, which makes SEU very attractive for students and its graduates' - for employers!

In 2009, SEU was accredited by the National Center for Education Accreditation, and in 2014 underwent re-authorization - which confirms the full compliance of the University with the goals of higher education in Georgia and the European Higher Education Area.

On June 10, 2021, the Council of Authorization of Higher Education Institutions unconditionally granted the authorization to Georgian National University SEU.

The members of the Authorization Council unanimously shared the draft report provided by the Panel of Authorization Experts, based on the SEU Self-Assessment Document and the information obtained by the Panel of Authorization Experts on the compliance of the SEU educational standards with the seven international standards.

At present, SEU has 4 faculties and 22 accredited (undergraduate, Master, single-step) educational programs in business, law, social sciences, tourism and medicine, where up to 8000 students study and employ up to 500 academic and visiting staff. The University takes care of the development and development of new educational programs in the field of business technologies, education, public administration and others.

The SEU academic team is staffed by highly qualified, deeply experienced competent professionals who actively use modern literature, technologies, the new teaching methods and motivate students in the teaching / learning process to maximize self-realization.

The University has close partnerships with leading foreign higher education institutions, diplomatic corps or international organizations, therefore, students have the opportunity to participate in exchange programs, joint research projects, training, advanced or retraining programs, etc. At the same time, foreign nationals are getting education at SEU, successful foreign professors, researchers and practicing professionals are involved in the academic process.

ABOUT SEU

SEU is one of the most in-demand universities, as evidenced by the results of the Unified National Examinations and Mobility for 2014-2020. According to the data of the last 5 years, 5041 students have moved to SEU, which is a record number in Georgia. In the Unified National Examinations of 2020, with the first choice of entrants and the enrollment of students, in the "Top 10" of the most demanded private universities, SEU takes the honorable first place. And with the competition of all Georgian universities - it is the second, after Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University.

By employment rate of graduates SEU is among the "Top 5" universities. In order to promote the employment of students and graduates, employment forums are held annually, in which, as a rule, more than 150 successful companies of Georgia are represented.

SEU is located in the historical part of Tbilisi. This side is interesting from the educational and tourist point of view, as well as, convenient for public transport.

In 2007, SEU offered students an impressive learning building that has become a symbol of modern Tbilisi. Since 2018, SEU Advantages has added a new, state-of-the-art and multifunctional campus with accumulated educational and technological resources, training and recreational spaces, which is a qualitatively different concept and has no analogues. PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All persons having full general education, who possess the relevant document certified by the state (School Leaving Certificate) or the equivalent document and who obtain the right to study on the mentioned program based on the results of the Unified National Exams and undergo administrative registration at SEU shall have the right to study on the Bachelor's Program in Data Science and Artificial Intelligence.

Enrolment without passing Unified National Exams

According to the procedure established by the legislation of Georgia, it shall be admissible to study on the Bachelor's Program in Data Science and Artificial Intelligence without passing the Unified National Exams for:

- ✓ Foreign citizens and persons without citizenship, who received full general or equivalent education in a foreign country;
- ✓ Georgian citizens, who received full general or equivalent education abroad and studied abroad during the last 2 years of their full general education;
- ✓ Foreign citizens (except for the students participating in the joint higher educational programs and in exchange educational programs), who study/have studied and obtained credits/qualification in a foreign country at a higher educational institution recognized pursuant to the legislation of that country;
- ✓ Georgian citizens (except for the students participating in the joint higher educational programs and in exchange educational programs), who live/have lived, study/have studied and obtained credits/qualification in a foreign country at a higher educational institution recognized pursuant to the legislation of that country;
- ✓ In order to determine the knowledge of the language of the program by the persons willing to obtain the right to study without passing the Unified National Exams, the University conducts an interview and ensures the availability of the video recording of the mentioned interview to the Ministry of Education, Science, Sports and Culture.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All persons having full general education, who possess the relevant document certified by the state (School Leaving Certificate) or the equivalent document and who obtain the right to study on the mentioned program based on the results of the Unified National Exams shall have the right to study on the Bachelor's Program in Information Technologies.

Enrollment without passing the Unified National Examinations

According to the procedure established by the legislation of Georgia, it shall be admissible to study on the Bachelor's Program in Information Technologies without passing the Unified National Exams for:

- ✓ Foreign citizens and persons without citizenship, who received full general or equivalent education in a foreign country;
- ✓ Georgian citizens, who received full general or equivalent education abroad and studied abroad during the last 2 years of their full general education;
- ✓ Foreign citizens (except for the students participating in the joint higher educational programs and in exchange educational programs), who study/have studied and obtained credits/qualification in a foreign country at a higher educational institution recognized pursuant to the legislation of that country;
- ✓ Georgian citizens (except for the students participating in the joint higher educational programs and in exchange educational programs), who live/have lived, study/have studied and obtained credits/qualification in a foreign country at a higher educational institution recognized pursuant to the legislation of that country;
- ✓ In order to determine the knowledge of the language of the program by the persons willing to obtain the right to study without passing the Unified National Exams, the University conducts an interview and ensures the availability of the video recording of the mentioned interview to the Ministry of Education, Science, Sports and Culture.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

A person with a full general education, possessing a relevant state-issued (high school certificate) or equivalent document and based on the admissible results of the Unified National Examinations, is eligible to enter the undergraduate education program of Business Administration, following the administrative registration at Georgian National University SEU.

Enrollment without passing the Unified National Examinations

Enrollment, without passing the Unified National Examination in accordance with the rules established by the legislation of Georgia, is allowed:

- ✓ For foreign citizens and stateless persons who have received full general or equivalent education in a foreign country;
- ✓ For citizens of Georgia who have received full general or equivalent education in a foreign country and have studied in a foreign country for the last 2 years of full general education;

- ✓ BA program enables students to acquire practical skills necessary for entrepreneurship.
- ✓ BA programme strives to prepare creative-minded professionals who will be competitive both in local and international labour markets with a healthy ambition to be a leader and have a need for constant development.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- ✓ Students understand and analyze the role of all the core areas of business administration, such as mathematics, statistics, management accounting and financial accounting, economics, finance, information technology, management, and marketing;

Students eligible for entering the programme without passing the Unified National Examinations:

- ✓ Georgian citizens, who received full secondary or equivalent education abroad and have studied the last two years of full secondary education in a foreign country;
- ✓ Individuals (except joint educational and exchange program students) who have lived abroad for the last one year or more, currently study/have studied and have received credits/qualification at an academic higher educational institution recognized under the laws of that country;
- ✓ Georgian citizens (except joint educational and exchange programs students) who have lived abroad for a time defined by the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia, currently study/have studied and have received credits/qualification at an academic higher educational institution recognized under the laws of that country.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

THE GOAL OF THE PROGRAMME

The goals of the Georgian National University SEU's undergraduate programme are as follows:

- ✓ To give theoretical knowledge about business and its environment. Students will gain knowledge about the principles of business functioning, the behavior of economic agents, and the regularities of the economic environment.
- ✓ To equip with theoretical knowledge and practical skills regarding the management of the organization. Students will learn the principles of performing various functions of the organization and their management; to learn about the management characteristics of organizations of different sizes and organizational designs; to understand the threats in the business environment and analyze their management methods; to study the importance of quality standards, advanced technologies and innovations in the modern business environment and ways to successfully implement them; to acquire the quantitative and qualitative tools needed for research;
- ✓ To acquire the ability to communicate in the business world. Students will develop skills such as written and oral communication in Georgian and foreign languages; they will study the organization's communication in the internal and external environment and the use of modern technologies in this process;
- ✓ To develop the ability to work in a team and its management; realizing the peculiarities of the working environment; to learn about the specifics of working in a team, the motives of individual and team behavior; they will explore ways to respond quickly to problems and resolve conflicts while working in a team;
- ✓ To develop managerial thinking to manage oneself, the organization, activities in a global environment, relationships, and change. In the final phase of the programme, courses are introduced in the learning process, which, on the one hand, expands the knowledge already acquired by the student, and on the other hand, especially strengthens the practical component of the educational program. Students will explore the features and approaches of management in a multicultural environment; learn about the methods of implementing strategies in different types of markets and analyzing the internal and external environment; mastering the methods and features of project management.

LEARNING OUTCOMES



- ✓ Student will be able to realize the behaviour of the individual as a product of the environment, individual diversity and personal experience; identifying the structure of behaviour and its underlying processes and mental mechanisms, becoming familiar with modern theories about personality and being aware of how to compare the bio-genetic, social and personal approaches to understanding a person's personality;
- ✓ Student will be aware of the approaches of cognitive psychology to describe the assessable manifestations of the human psyche, the methodology of studying human cognitive processes, distinguishing between cognitive and affective processes of the psyche;
- ✓ Student will be familiar with the classical approach of the Georgian School of Psychology with respect to the theory of explanatory mood behaviour and will be able to identify personality types and determine the nature of mood using the classical method of fixed mood:
- ✓ Student will be capable of selecting adequate methods for obtaining empirical data, reveals theoretical and practical skills for conducting experimental-psychological research and processing results;
- ✓ Student will be able to interpret information using quantitative and qualitative methods, considering the statistical significance and cause-and-affect, using SPSS and transforming primary data into the variables he/she needs, calculating descriptive and final statistics, connecting with each other and establishing cause-and-effect relationships between them, as well as to evaluate the results and make a conclusion adhering to the norms of academic style ensuring the presentation of research results.

In obtaining the academic degree of Master of Clinical Psychology, the student deeply and systematically:

- Describes the main forms of mental and behavioral disorders and their principles of diagnosis, classification and management;
- Describes and explains the basic psych diagnostic methods, the principles of their selection, interprets the obtained results;
- ✓ Explains mental disorders, prophylactic, therapeutic and rehabilitation methods, and analyzes the principles of ethical standards of psychological counseling;
- ✓ Analyzes the role of different brain systems in human behavior;

- ✓ Evaluates his/her own practice in the field of clinical psychology, participates in professional discussions to share his/her own practice, and studies in the context of differences of opinion;

Providing first aid in emergency medical situations (First aid and resuscitation measures)

✓ Identify and assess the emergency medical conditions, treat emergency medical conditions, provide with first aid; age peculiarities in newborns and children; conduct the basic life maintaining and cardiopulmonary resuscitation activities in compliance with the guidelines; conduct the activities for enhance lifetime maintenance in accordance with the guidelines; treat of traumas according to the guidelines.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION PRECONDITION:

The prerequisites and procedures for admission to the dental educational program are in accordance with the current legislation, it is written in the program, in the regulation of the educational process, it is posted on the website of the university and it is available to all interested person. - ✓ The university conducts an interview to determine the language proficiency of the program of persons wishing to obtain the right to study without passing the unified national exams and ensures the availability of the video recording of the interview to the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of Georgia;
